IMPORTANT: Please read both sides of this letter carefully.

Dear Student:

Good health is essential for achieving your educational and personal goals. Because maintaining good health requires access to health care when you need it, Georgetown University School of Foreign Service in Qatar requires registered students to have health insurance at all times. Qatari citizens and residents are eligible for the State of Qatar national health coverage. SFS-Qatar will arrange for international students to obtain their national health card after their arrival to Qatar. To extend our students’ access to private health services, **all** enrolled SFS-Qatar students are required to have a supplementary private health insurance in addition to national health coverage. For all students, SFS-Qatar has negotiated a comprehensive health and travel coverage, called StudentCare Plus Plan.

All students are charged \$470.97 USD at the beginning of each academic year for the StudentCare Plus Plan designed for SFS-Qatar students. SFS-Qatar Student Wellness Counseling is responsible for enrolling students into the student health insurance plan and will assist, as needed with issues related to their claims.

For more information regarding benefits and enrollment in the StudentCare Plus Plan, refer to the StudentCare Medical and Travel Insurance policy, the Schedule of Benefits and Fees, and the claim form included in your admissions package. Because you are responsible for understanding your health benefits, carefully read the enrollment and benefit details, including the exclusions and limitations throughout the policy, especially general exclusions on pages 20 and 21. Please note that certain circumstances, such as in-patient and day-care treatments and procedures, require prior approval from the insurance company as directed by the policy (pages 6 and 9).

Coverage for Spouse and/or Dependent Children Under Age 21

2009-10 StudentCare Plus Plan Waiver

Some students may already have adequate private health insurance. If this is the case for you, you may choose to waive out of the StudentCare Plus Plan offered by SFS-Qatar. Please compare your current private health insurance policy with the StudentCare Plus Plan policy to make a decision about opting out of the university insurance plan. To be a suitable replacement for the university insurance plan, your insurance policy needs to provide coverage in the State of Qatar with no less than \$100,000 per illness and \$100,000 per injury, some mental health coverage, and travel insurance. You must provide a copy of your existing private insurance with this letter to waive out of StudentCare Plus Plan. Otherwise you will be automatically enrolled and charge for the plan. If you would like to maximize your health care access, you may choose to remain covered under your current private health insurance while also enrolling in the StudentCare Plus Plan.

- I would like to waive out of enrolling in the StudentCare Plus Plan designed for SFS-Qatar students. I am enclosing a copy of my existing private insurance card that is compatible with the StudentCare Plus Plan in covering my medical expenses in Qatar.

All students will be enrolled in and charged for the StudentCare Plus Plan UNLESS the box above is checked and returned to us along with a copy of your current private health insurance and Qatar National Health Card (if you have it already) by July 1st, sealed in the provided envelope.
